NUTCRACKER 2009 **REINDEER CAST INFORMATION**

Welcome to the Cast of *NUTCRACKER 2009*. You have been cast in the role of a **REINDEER**.

THEATRE ORIENTATION

Sunday, Dec. 6 9:00 – 10:00am Theatre Orientation

Attendance at the Theatre Orientation is **MANDATORY** for all cast members and **AT LEAST** one parent or guardian. The Orientation is designed to provide parents and cast members with important safety information and what to expect when in the theatre. Failure to attend the orientation may result in dismissal from the cast.

THEATRE REHEARSALS

REINDEER rehearse only at the Academy of Music. Reindeer will be fit for costumes immediately following their rehearsal on stage.

Sunday, Dec. 6 10:00 – 11:00am ALL REINDEER Arrive back at Theatre for rehearsal

Thursday, Dec. 10 Full Dress Rehearsal for Sunday 1:00 cast of REINDEER ONLY
6:00pm – Arrive at Theatre
7:00 – 9:00pm Full Dress Rehearsal

Rehearsal Rules: Rehearsals prepare your children for their performance in *The Nutcracker*. **Attendance at ALL rehearsals is required.** Missed rehearsals compromise not only the individual's safety and ability to learn, but also the group performance. If you have an emergency and need to miss rehearsal you **MUST** notify an artistic director prior to rehearsal.

PERFORMANCES: Friday Dec. 11, 4:00 & 7:30pm
Saturday Dec. 12, 1:00 & 4:30pm
Sunday Dec. 13, 1:00 & 4:30pm

Reindeer need to arrive 1 hour before their performance. All performances are held at the Academy of Music, 274 Main Street, Northampton, MA. For dancers' safety, **no one will be allowed to videotape, audiotape or photograph any rehearsal or performance. Absolutely no food or drink is allowed in the audience.**

All cast members use "stage door" (South Street entrance). Dancers under the age of 14 will only be allowed to leave the theatre when signed out by a parent or guardian, and IDs will be checked to ensure dancers' safety.

Sign in and go to dressing rooms for make-up and costume (in that order). Children **should bring water** to drink.

Costumes: Reindeer need solid white underwear. No jewelry of any kind (including pierced earrings) may be worn on stage. Dancers are not allowed to leave the theater in costume or in makeup at any time.

Make-up notes: For hygienic purposes all cast members must provide their own make-up. Reindeer must bring:

- Foundation, pancake, or base, one shade darker than skintone.
- Charcoal black eyeliner PENCIL.
- Any wine color lipstick without purple tints.

-Dancers should bring their makeup in a ziplock bag labeled with their name. When they are called for makeup, they will bring their bag and hand it to the makeup person.

-Dancers must also provide their own hairbrushes, hair supplies, face wipes, and make-up removers.

-Dancers should wear button down shirts (no pullovers or turtlenecks!).

NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE THEATRE WEARING STAGE MAKE-UP.

Tickets: The enclosed ticket brochure provides you, your family and your friends the opportunity to purchase priority seating, at a discount, before public sale of tickets begins. Tickets will also be available at Pioneer Valley Ballet and Tix.com beginning on November 2nd.

Volunteers: Please return the enclosed volunteer form to PVB. We need your help! *The Nutcracker* would not be possible without the help of parent volunteers. Whether it be child care, sewing or makeup, we need you. Please choose which of those areas you would like to help out with, as we require at least 1 parent or guardian of each cast member to volunteer to help make our shows the best they can be.

DVDS: DVD order forms will be available at the studio prior to the performances as well as during the performances. For dancers' safety, no one will be allowed to videotape, audiotape, or photograph any rehearsal or performance.
